The University of Economics, Prague (Vysoká škola ekonomická v Praze – VŠE) is the leading University in the fields of management and economics in the Czech Republic with more than 20 000 students and 700 professors. The EU Commission awarded VŠE the ECTS and DS labels for the 2009–2013 period.

### BACHELOR OF ECONOMICS

The main objective of the program is to create qualified professional economists who will be able to come into the public and private sectors nationally or internationally. **These professionals will have a strong base in economics, legal sciences and other social disciplines with a special emphasis on international economics and politics.** With a sufficient and varied base, the graduates from this program will be able to respond to the ever-changing and increasingly demanding requirements of business practices and labor markets, both nationally and internationally. **The program is aimed at talented local and foreign students who want, above all, to continue in master's programs and disciplines that are taught in English at the University of Economics, as well as students who are willing to continue their studies abroad.** The standard length of study is 3 years.

### DEGREE

**The bachelor's degree in Economics is a Czech national degree awarded by the University of Economics, Prague.** Graduates are entitled to use the title Bc. according to Czech legislation.

### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

- Three-year (six semester) full-time bachelor's program
- Taught in English
- Workload of 180 ECTS credits





## COURSES

- **Core courses (120 ECTS)** Money, Banking and Financial Institutions; Fundamentals of Accounting, Marketing and Business Economics, Statistics, Mathematics for Economists, Economic Propedeutics, Writing Skills, Economics, Microeconomics I, Macroeconomics I, Public Sector Economics, Introducing to Philosophy, Economic History, Introduction to Economic and Social Policy, Introduction to Law and Economics, Elements of Law and Jurisprudence, Introductory Econometrics, Introduction to Game Theory, Discussion Seminar, Labor Seminar, Applied Quantitative Methods I.
- **Elective Courses (54 ECTS)** Institutional Analysis of Non Market Interactions, Drugs in Economics, Chapters from Economic Policy, Economics of Transformation, Economics of Vice, Disputes in Monetary Theory, Economics and Psychology, Fundamentals of Experimental Economics, Chicago School, etc.
- **Final State exams and bachelor's thesis (6 ECTS)**
